Article X, Method of Election



#### New Proposed language:

- a. <u>In the event of a tie for any office the following procedure will be</u> Followed:
- 1. The tie will be broken by a coin toss.
- 2. If there is an incumbent they will select heads or tails.
- 3. If there is NO incumbent the President or their designee will assign heads or tails to the candidates.
- 4. The coin will be flipped in the air by the President or their designee and allowed to hit the ground to determine the selection for the tie position. The candidate with their selected or assigned heads or tails coin position will be the winner as determined by the results of which side, heads or tails is facing upwards.


## The Website
