2) Fellow magicians may be interested in this little tidbit lesson learned. After viewing the video I realized that I need to improve my stage blocking. At rehearsal the night before I saw the program for the first time and came up with the gag about my picture on the cover. I inserted it into the act at the last minute (which is a recipe for disaster). I hadn't thought through or rehearsed my movements and as you can see in the video I bumble around putting my hat and can down, interrupting the flow of the act.


I write-up all our acts. To address that problem, I added this Stage Blocking section below to the write-up for future performances. Thought I would share this method and template which I find useful for planning movement on stage. It is simple but effective.

## **Stage Blocking**

Stage blocking in general is as follows.

- Magician confines his movements to left of center
- Assistant confines his movements to right of center.
- Magician uses chair center stage for props.
- Magician steps forward DC to mime cartoon on cover of program.
- Magician takes ropes into audience for examination.
- Magician carries table forward for Newspaper Tear and moves off to side CL before taking paper from assistant, to remove table from focus.
